REDEMPTION OF VARIOUS THIRD PARTY LIENS**


WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick has received the amount necessary to redeem certain liens held by third parties; and




**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE
OF A FEDERAL GRANT FROM
THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY
DIVISION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY**

WHEREAS, North Brunswick Township desires to apply for and to accept the "2014 Distracted Driving Crackdown" reimbursement funds in the amount of \$5,000. to reduce the number of motor vehicle fatalities in the state with a distracted driving contributing cause by five percent from the 2010-2012 calendar base year average through targeted distracted driving enforcement and education during the 2014 Distracted Driving Crackdown; and


WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the 2014 Distracted Driving Crackdown mobilization from April 1-21, 2014 in an effort to reduce the rate of distracted driving related fatalities in the State; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of North Brunswick Township to apply for said monies, with no matching funds required. The maximum project overtime rate is \$50.00 per hour. Officers paid more than \$50.00 per hour will be reimbursed at \$50.00 per hour by the grant with the municipality covering the remainder of the rate;



WHEREAS, this Agreement is between the North Brunswick Township Police Department and the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces (OCDETF) Program. The Agreement is authorized by the North Brunswick Director of Police, the sponsoring Federal Agency Special Agent-In-Charge, the sponsoring Agency Regional OCDETF Coordinator, the Assistant United States Attorney Regional OCDETF Coordinator, and the OCDETF Executive Office for federal monies available from the OCDETF Program; and

WHEREAS, the North Brunswick Township Police Department seeks to participate in the OCDETF Strategic Initiative by assigning two officers from their respective department;

WHEREAS, the OCDETF Program has committed from federal funds the amount of four thousand (\$4,000.) dollars to the Township of North Brunswick as a form of compensation for the commitment of two officers from December 16, 2013 to September 30, 2014; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, on this 3rd Day of March 2014, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, Middlesex County, New Jersey, authorizes the Director of Public Safety to accept the Federal Reimbursement Agreement in the amount of \$4,000.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT BID13013
WITH HIGH TECH LANDSCAPES INC. FOR
TREE REMOVAL AND TREE TRIMMING SERVICES**

UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Township Council previously authorized the Township to enter into a contract with High Tech Landscapes, Inc. (10 Culnen Drive, Branchburg, NJ 08876) for tree removal and tree trimming services with a term commencing on January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2015, with an option to renew the contract for two (2) additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, compensation was agreed to be paid at an hourly rate of \$170.00 per regular hours and an hourly rate of \$180.00 for weekend hours for a three (3) man crew, with an estimated 525 hours, totaling \$91,250.00 as an "open ended" contract; and

WHEREAS, previously, of the \$91,250.00 authorized, funds in the amount of \$5,630.00 were made available in the Parks operating budget, account 4-01-28-375-000-178, and the balance was to be made available contingent upon appropriation of funds within the FY2015 budget or in future fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, with current poor weather conditions, the projected costs for the remainder of this fiscal year is projected to exceed the anticipated allocation of \$5,630.00; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Lou Ann Benson, the Director for the Department, to amend the amount currently authorized to \$10,800.00; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$5,170.00 have been made available in the Parks operating budget 4-01-28-375-000-178 and the balance shall be made available contingent upon appropriation of funds within the FY2015 budget or in future fiscal years; and



**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK AMENDING
CONTRACT BID12001 P&A CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE
2012 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT
CLOSEOUT CHANGE ORDER (\$359,499.07)**

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development is responsible for construction and improvements of Township streets, roads and curbing; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has previously authorized a contract with P & A Construction, Inc. (PO Box 28 Colonia, NJ 07067) for the 2012 Road Improvement Program, Contract BID12001, in the amount of \$2,744,826.60 for Items 1 through 120 inclusive, exclusive of Hollywood Street improvements, pending approval by the New Jersey Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, at the time of the bid opening the Township had not received New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) approval for Hollywood Street improvements, as part of the 2012 New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid portion of the 2012 Road Program; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2012, CME Associates, engineering firm for this project, notified the Township that the New Jersey Department of Transportation approved the 2012 New Jersey Department of Transportation Municipal Aid portion of the 2012 Road Program for Hollywood Street in the amount of \$250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, due to increases and decreases in quantities and supplemental work required to complete the 2012 road program, including the addition of improvements to Hollywood Street, partially grant funded, there was a net increase in the contract amount by \$548,962.53 (Change Order No. 1) for a revised contract of \$3,293,789.13; and

WHEREAS, with favorable conditions, P & A Construction, Inc. has presented a Closeout Change Order that reflects reductions and increases in contract quantities and supplementary items required to satisfactorily complete the 2012 road program, resulting in a net reduction in the contract amount of (\$359,499.07); and


WHEREAS, CME Associates, engineering firm for this project, has reviewed and indicated in a report attached hereto that this Closeout Change Order reflects reductions and increases in contract quantities and supplementary items required to satisfactorily complete the 2012 Road Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Township Council of North Brunswick to amend the contract with P & A Construction, Inc. to reduce the contract amount by (\$359,499.07) (Closeout Change Order) for a revised contract of \$2,934,290.06; and







WHEREAS, the Fire Department – Fines/Permits Trust account has sufficient funding that will be made available for this purchase; and


