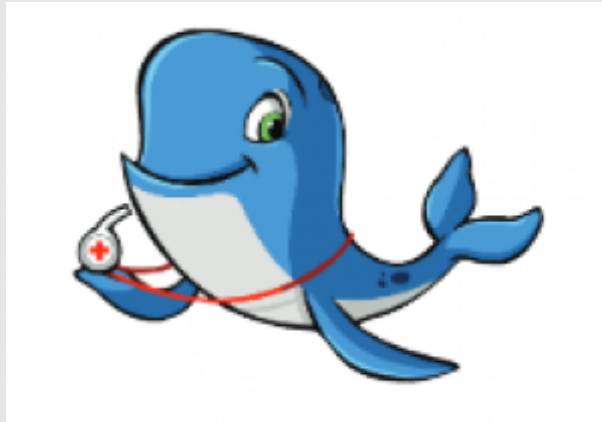


**TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK DEPARTMENT OF
