

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK  
CONFIRMING AN EMERGENCY AND  
AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR OF A JET VAC TRUCK  
UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Stormwater Management Division is responsible for maintaining the entire Township stormwater infrastructure in accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Stormwater Best Management Practices; and

**WHEREAS**, jet-vac trucks are the ideal way to maintain healthy stormwater systems to effectively clean catch basins, removing grit, leaves and other debris through vacuum and high-pressure water; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to repair vehicle #863 (2006 Sterling LT7500) within the Stormwater Division that currently needs a replacement debris tank; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of North Brunswick has a need to acquire the services to replace the debris tank as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined and certified in writing that the repair will exceed \$17,500.00; and

**WHEREAS**, FS Solutions (17 Jules Lane New Brunswick, NJ 08901) has submitted a proposal to repair the debris tank in the amount of \$39,428.40; and

**WHEREAS**, prior to entering onto a contract with the Township, FS Solutions will have completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification, attached hereto, which certifies that they have not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of North Brunswick in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit FS Solutions from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, FS Solutions has completed and submitted a C.271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form, attached hereto, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 et seq.; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby confirm the emergency and the award of a contract made with FS Solutions in the amount of \$39,428.40 for the emergency repair of the debris tank on the jet-vac truck within the Stormwater Division.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 2021, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute, and the Township Clerk to witness, an agreement with FS Solutions for the repair of the debris tank on Vehicle #863, in the amount of \$39,428.40.

A jet-vac truck is a piece of equipment utilized by the Sewer and Stormwater Divisions to clean underground pipes, catch basins, and manholes of debris to help materials flow through the pipes and prevent blockages. The Township currently owns two of these vehicles, one for each Division and they are shared at times for emergencies and when one is out for service. The unit used in sewer, will at times, collect materials that would need to be disposed of at a landfill which prevents the use of one unit to both departments unless there was such an emergency. The oldest of the two, a 2006 Vaccon, has developed a major issue with the debris tank. Over the years, the tank, which is made of metal, has fatigued causing open hose which will not allow the unit to vacuum accurately. Due to the extent of the wear and damage to the tank and the danger this may cause to life and property, I am asking that we declare an emergency to have this unit repaired because it is a vital piece of equipment to both Divisions.
