

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 334 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
TO AMEND COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PARKING REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 et seq., permits a municipality to enact an ordinance regulating the parking of vehicles on streets and portions thereof and to establish certain traffic controls and erect appropriate signs without NJDOT review or approval; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Community Development, in conjunction with the Traffic Safety Bureau, has determined that parking and traffic conditions on various streets should be amended to promote pedestrian and traffic safety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, that Chapter 334-30, Vehicles and Traffic, be hereby amended with a new section 334-3.2, Commercial Vehicle Parking Prohibited at all times on certain streets, as follows:

§ 334-3.2 Commercial Vehicle Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets.

No person shall park a commercial vehicle specified in Schedule I: No Parking (334-30(C)) of any day upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said Schedule I attached and made a part of this chapter.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Chapter 334-30, Vehicles and Traffic, Article XIV Schedule I: No Parking, be and is hereby amended to include a new section 334-30(C) as follows:

§ 334-30 Schedule I: No Parking.

C. In accordance with the provisions of § 334-3.2, no person shall park a commercial vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Morris Drive	West	From Renaissance Boulevard North to Marc Drive
Oak Road	East	From 189 feet of the northerly curblineline of Adams Lane to a point 630 feet of the easterly curblineline of Oak Road.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall

apply only to the section paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.

TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Ordinance Authorizing the Amendment of Parking and Traffic Conditions on Renaissance Boulevard and Morris Drive
