## ICE SKATING RINK RULES & REGULATIONS

Ice Skating may cause serious injury. All Park participants under 5 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.

### **IMPORTANT! Please read and remember these PARK RULES**

**The park's success and use requires strict compliance to these rules and regulations.**

- No use of cell phones while on ice.
  - Each user must perform an inspection of the entire ice area before use.
  - All users must fill out and complete the waiver before getting onto the ice rink.
  - All users must wear their registration wristband while in the park.
  - Spectators permitted on the outside of ice rink only.  
    Know your skill level -skate within your ability.
- All users must skate responsibly, exercising common sense and courtesy.
- All safety equipment must be securely fastened. During your time on the ice check your skates.
  - Smoking, drugs, alcohol, profanity, vandalism, recklessness and/or disruptive behavior in the ice rink area are prohibited and will result in immediate expulsion from the Park.
  - Do not trespass -respect the posted hours of operation.
  - All users must abide by all directions, commands, or orders of any DPRCS Staff members.
  - No glass, food or beverages are permitted on the ice surface. Keep it clean. This is YOUR park--own it.
  - Don't skate when the rink is snow covered.
  - Store your gear outside the ice surface. DPRCS Staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
  - Report emergencies or injuries immediately to the DPRCS Staff Members.
  - Masks MUST be worn in common spaces. Masks can be off when engaging in skate on ice.
  - Please report damages or unsafe conditions immediately to the Department of Parks and Recreation Staff Member on site or call the office at (732) 247-0922 ext. 475
