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A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF NORTH BRUNSWICK AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH DECOTIIS, FITZPATRICK, COLE & GIBLIN, LLP TO SERVE AS MUNICIPAL LABOR COUNSEL

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick has a need for a professional to perform the duties as Municipal Labor Counsel for calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2021, the Township Council approved Resolution 278-9.21, authorizing the solicitation of Requests for Proposals (RFP) for said professional services; and

WHEREAS, services were procured in formal manner in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1a et seq., under both a fair and open and competitive process to assure that each person and/or firm is provided an equal opportunity to respond to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, November 10, 2021, the Purchasing Agent received, and the Municipal Clerk witnessed, the receipt of two proposals in response to PRO22007; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee, designated to review proposals and make a recommendation, has completed the review process and included herein their Evaluation Report; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee recommends authorizing a contract with the firm DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP (61 South Paramus Road Suite 250 Paramus, NJ 07020) and determined them responsive in all respects and qualified for the position; and

WHEREAS, proposals have been reviewed and the response submitted by DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP has been determined to be responsive under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 40A:11-1 et seq. and any provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, compensation for these services shall be billed at an hourly rate of \$175.00 for partners and associates, a blended hourly rate of \$95.00 for clerks and paralegals, travel, and reimbursable expenses as described within the contract for a total authorization not-to-exceed \$60,000.00 for calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that \$25,000.00 is available for this purpose in FY2022 budget account 2-01-20-155-000-983 for services ending June 30, 2022 and the balance shall be certified upon the appropriation of funds in FY2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 3rd day of January, 2022, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an agreement with firm DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole &

Giblin, LLP to serve as Labor Counsel, with a contract authorization not-to-exceed \$60,000.00 for calendar year 2022, in accordance with RFP PRO22007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED notice of this action shall be published in the Home News & Tribune as required by law within 10 (ten) days after its passage.

EVALUATION REPORT 2022 TOWNSHIP LABOR COUNSEL - REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL DECEMBER 20, 2021

As part of its annual award of professional service agreements in accordance with "Fair and Open" procurement process established in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq., North Brunswick Township solicited Requests for Proposals (RFP) for Township Labor Counsel for calendar year 2022.

On September 27, 2021. the Township Council passed Resolution #278-9.21 authorizing the solicitation of proposals for this service. The process under a formal RFP allows for factors other than price to be taken into consideration when awarding a contract. This process also requires that a committee be established to evaluate proposals in accordance with "weighted" criteria established prior to solicitation of proposals.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C 5:34-4.3, the Township established a three (3) person committee comprised of the following individuals:

Joseph Battaglia Chief of Public Safety

Erik Jacobsen Police Lieutenant

William Lovas Police Sergeant

Each committee member assessed their own affiliations and financial interest, as well as the affiliations and financial interests of family members, to ensure that there was no conflict with potential vendors. Each member signed a statement attesting to the fact that there was no conflict of interest.

The committee reviewed and discussed the Request for Proposal and alternative evaluation criteria. The committee agreed to the criteria to be evaluated and the numerical weighting to be assigned to each. The established weighting criterion was as follows:

- 1. Understanding and Prior Experience with the township -30 points
- 2. Experience and Qualifications of Individuals 20 points
- 3. Overall company history 30 points
- 4. Agreement to the Pricing Model 20 points

There were two (2) proposals received by the submission deadline:

DeCotiis, FitzPatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP 61 South Paramus Road Suite 250 Paramus, NJ 07652

The committee members individually reviewed the proposal. The committee then met to discuss the proposal including: experience, proposed methodology and other factors.

DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP received a total score of 297 out of a possible 300. Rainone, Coughlin Minchello received a total score of 262 out of a possible 300.

DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP has served as the Township's Labor Counsel for several years now. They received high scores in all areas. Evaluators ranked their experience high based on past performance in 2021 dealing with labor related matters.

The committee therefore recommends the award of contract PRO22007 to DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick & Cole LLP for submitting a proposal that is responsive to the Township's needs and in accordance with the pre-established weighting criteria.
