A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DAVID P. LONSKI OF THE FIRM SHAMY, SHIPERS & LONSKI, PC TO SERVE AS MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, November 10, 2021, the Purchasing Agent received, and the Municipal Clerk witnessed, the receipt of one proposal in response to PRO2204; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee, designated to review proposals and make a recommendation, has completed the review process and included herein their Evaluation Report; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee recommends authorizing a contract with David P. Lonski (or his designee) of the firm Shamy, Shipers & Lonski, PC to serve as Municipal Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, the response submitted by David P. Lonski of the firm Shamy, Shipers & Lonski, PC has been determined to be responsive under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law <u>N.J.S.A</u>. 40A:11-1 et seq. and any provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, compensation for these services shall be paid at a rate of \$275.00 per session for regularly scheduled and special sessions and reimbursable expenses in an amount not-to-exceed \$56,000.00 for calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that \$30,000.00 is available for this purpose in account 2-01-20-155-000-982 for services ending June 30, 2022 and the balance of funds shall be certified upon the appropriation of funds in FY2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 3rd day of January 2022, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an agreement with David P. Lonski (or his designee) of the firm Shamy, Shipers & Lonski, PC to serve as Municipal Prosecutor, with an authorization not-to-exceed \$56,000.00, for calendar year 2022, in accordance with RFP PRO22004.
