

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH
STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. TO PROVIDE
WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM OVERSIGHT SERVICES
FOR THE NORTH BRUNSWICK WASTEWATER SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick has a need to acquire Wastewater Collection System Oversight services for the municipally owned and operated wastewater system for calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2021, the Township Council approved Resolution 278-9.21, authorizing the solicitation of Requests for Proposals (RFP) for said services; and

WHEREAS, services were procured in formal manner in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1a et seq., under both a fair and open and competitive process to assure that each person and/or firm is provided an equal opportunity to respond to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday November 10, 2021, the Purchasing Agent received, and the Municipal Clerk witnessed, the receipt of three proposals in response to PRO22019; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee, designated to review proposals and make a recommendation, has completed the review process and included herein their Evaluation Report; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee recommends authorizing a contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (1971 Route 34, Wall Township, New Jersey 07719) to provide for Wastewater Collection System Oversight Services; and

WHEREAS, proposals have been reviewed and the response submitted by Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. has been determined to be responsive under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. and any provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Township of North Brunswick to enter into an agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., for Wastewater Collection System Oversight services for calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. shall be compensated for these services as outlined within their contract for an authorization not-to-exceed \$20,000.00 for general services, exclusive of special projects that may be requested by the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that \$10,000.00 is available for this purpose in account 2-07-55-502-000-200 for general services ending June 30, 2022 and the balance of funds shall be certified upon the appropriation of funds in FY2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 3rd day of January, 2022, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to provide for Wastewater Collection System Oversight services, with an authorization not-to-exceed \$20,000.00, exclusive of special projects, for calendar year 2022, in accordance with RFP PRO22019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED notice of this action shall be published in the Home News & Tribune as required by law within 10 (ten) days after its passage.

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EVALUATION REPORT
WASTEWATER COLLECTION OVERSIGHT SERVICES
REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PRO22019
DECEMBER 26, 2021

North Brunswick Department of Public Works desires the services of a professional firm to assist in the wastewater collection oversight. This service will be used by the North Brunswick Public Works Sewer Division.

The Township Council passed a resolution authorizing the solicitation of proposals for this through a competitive contracting process. This process allows for other factors other than price to be taken into consideration in awarding a contract. This process also requires that a committee be established to evaluate proposals in accordance with “weighted” criteria established prior to solicitation of proposals.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C 5:34-4.3, the Township established a three-person committee comprised of the following individuals:

Steve Bloyed, Superintendent of Sewer
Salvatore Georgianna, Sewer Supervisor
Eric Chaszar, Director of Public Works

In addition to the committee reviewing proposals, Legal Counsel was engaged to reviewed proposals submitted for legal compliance.

Each committee member assessed their own affiliations and financial interest, as well as the affiliations and financial interests of family members, to ensure that there was no conflict of interest with vendors in the field. Each member signed a statement attesting to the fact that there was no conflict of interest.

The committee reviewed the proposal evaluation criteria. The committee agreed to the criteria to be evaluated and the numerical weighting to be assigned to each area. The established weighting criterion was as follows:

- History and Understanding of Service- 0-30 points
- Prior Experience of Individual/ Team Identified- 0-20 points
- Overall Company History w/similar services- 0-30 points
- Agreement to pricing model- 0-20points

On September 27, 2021, the Township Council passed resolution 278-9.21 authorizing the solicitation of proposals for said service. The following three (3) proposals were received by the submission deadline of November 10, 2021.

The committee members individually reviewed each proposal and filled out Committee Evaluation Forms, assigning numerical scores for each firm.

It was determined that Stantec and CME Associates have participated in Township Public Work Sewer Meetings in the past and understand the township's history. It was noted that Remington & Vernick has performed work in the Township, though not related to Wastewater collection. Stantec scored the highest at 280, CME 217, Remington & Vernick 195.

As a result of its evaluation on December 26, 2021, the committee recommended that Stantec be awarded the contract based upon overall scoring on the criteria established and review of the proposal.
