

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF NORTH BRUNSWICK  
AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE RECEIPT OF BIDS  
FOR THE NORTH BRUNSWICK COMMUNITY PARK  
TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, approximately 20-years ago, the Township acquired approximately 100 acres of undeveloped land along Route 130S, Block 148, Lot 103, known today as North Brunswick Community Park; and

**WHEREAS**, since becoming municipal property, the site has been developed as a park, which includes a 2.2-mile *gravel* walking trail that loops the perimeter; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2021, the Township received \$500,000.00 in Special Project Funding from Assemblyman Joe Danielsen’s Office towards paving a section of the trail, to serve the greater community population, making it Stroller and Wheelchair Friendly; and

**WHEREAS**, in April of 2022, the Township engaged municipal engineering firm CME Associates to provide design through bid phase services associated with the North Brunswick Community Park Trail Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, with design through bid phase services complete, a recommendation is hereby made for the Township to solicit proposals for this project, known as the Community Park Trail Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the goods and services requested is anticipated to exceed the current bid threshold, and is therefore required to be bid under a formal competitive bid process pursuant to Local Public Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3 et seq.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 2022, that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick does hereby authorize advertisement for the receipt of bids for the following specification:

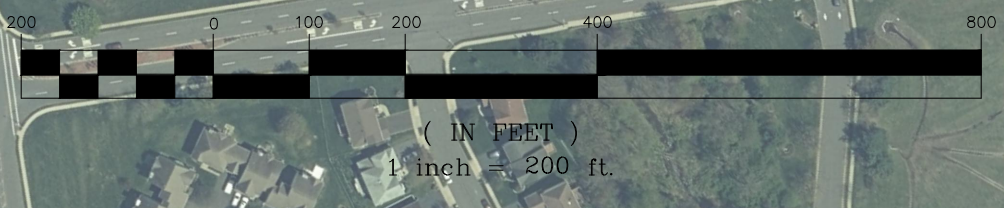

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The Township can't thank you enough for assisting municipalities with financial assistance for projects. Below are a few projects in need of matching funds to get them over the finish line. We listed more than one for you to review and consider based on how you would best like to see funds spent.

### **Request for Consideration 1 - Agriculture & Rural Parkland Development**

#### **North Brunswick Community Park – pavement of walking trail project \$500,000 – 1 Year Construction**

The 100 acres of land was acquired by the Township approximately 20-years ago and underwent the first major phase of construction about 15-years ago. There is still much potential this park can offer with some additional improvements.

Within the park there is a 2.2 mile moderately trafficked loop trail. This is primarily used for walking and running and is accessible year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. By paving the gravel path, the trail would then be available to serve the greater community population, by now being Stroller friendly, Wheelchair friendly and Kid friendly.
