

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK  
AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT  
WITH MIDDLESEX COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY  
FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF RECYCLING MATERIAL**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works Division of Sanitation is responsible for the collection of recyclable refuse generated by residents and various approved entities located within the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. (the “Act”), authorizes local units of this State to enter into agreements with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive in its own jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 1, 2020, pursuant to Resolution #169-6.20, the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick authorized a shared services agreement with the Middlesex County Improvement Authority (MCIA) to provide for the collection of recyclables in the Township of North Brunswick; and

**WHEREAS**, the current contract for collection of refuse and recyclables at apartment complexes in North Brunswick with Central Jersey Waste will have expired on August 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 1, 2022, pursuant to Resolution #233-8.22, the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick authorized a contract with Interstate Waste Services of New Jersey dba Central Jersey Waste to provide refuse ONLY collection services to Apartment Complexes pursuant to contract BID22005; and

**WHEREAS**, in agreement with the MCIA, the Township of North Brunswick would like to add apartment complexes to the current shared services agreement with the Middlesex County Improvement Authority for the collection and disposal of recycling materials starting September 1, 2022.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 2022 that the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, in consideration of the mutual and joint obligations set forth herein and other valuable considerations hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute and the Township Clerk to witness an amendment to the Shared Services agreement with the Middlesex County Improvement Authority (MCIA) for the collection of recyclable generated refuse at the rates provided within their current bid.
