A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH ELECTRICAL POWER SYSTEMS FOR ESSENTIAL ELECTRIC GENERATION SERVICES FOR TEMPORARY PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES

WHEREAS, Hurricane Ida impacted New Jersey on Wednesday, September 1, 2021, bringing severe weather conditions including strong winds, and heavy and sustained rainfall in some areas; and

WHEREAS, the storm caused severe damage to municipal facilities, infrastructure, and equipment, including the Municipal Complex which housed municipal operations including 9-1-1 Dispatch and Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Servpro Disaster Recovery Services previously procured electric generation services from Electrical Power Systems (17A Palisade Avenue, Emerson, NJ 07630) to support temporary trailer facilities on a monthly basis for the aforementioned departments under their contract authorized on March 6, 2023 pursuant to Resolution 98-3.23; and

WHEREAS, Servpro Disaster Recovery Service's contract has concluded but there is still a need for the mobile trailers, and thus electric generation services, which house essential services such as 9-1-1 Dispatch and Public Safety, a disruption to which would threaten the safety and welfare of Township residents; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-6(a), the Township may award a contract on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, Electrical Power Systems provided the Township with the attached quote for the monthly rental of seven panels, breakers, and transformers to support the essential operations of 9-1-1 Dispatch and Public Safety out of temporary trailer facilities without an interruption in service; and

WHEREAS, Electrical Power Systems completed and submitted a C.271 Political Contributions Disclosure Form pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 et seq.; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, does hereby authorize the emergency contract with Electrical Power Systems for the monthly rental of seven panels, breakers, and transformers to power the operations of essential municipal services until they can be returned to the Municipal Complex with a not-to-exceed amount of \$44,100.00.
