**WORKSHOP MEETING
March 11, 2024**

A workshop meeting of the North Brunswick Township Council was held on Monday, March 11, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the North Brunswick Board of Education Meeting Room at Linwood School, 25 Linwood Place, North Brunswick, Middlesex County, New Jersey.

Mayor Womack called the meeting to order.
