

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING INFORMATIONAL UPDATE ON THE
COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK AND
THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY
AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME)
COUNCIL 73 AFL-CIO LOCAL 3834 SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick wishes to formally document certain updates and developments for the record; and

WHEREAS, the following information is being provided to the Township Council and the public for informational purposes only, and no formal action or decision is required; and

WHEREAS, in 2021, the Township of North Brunswick (the "Township") engaged in good faith negotiations with AFSCME Council 73 AFL-CIO Local 3834 (the "Union"), which represents a certain group of Township employees; and

WHEREAS, in October of 2021, these negotiations resulted in a Memorandum of Agreement, which amended sections of the existing Collective Bargaining Agreement and was approved by Council action pursuant to Resolution 300-10.21; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement has been incorporated into the proposed new Collective Bargaining Agreement (the "Agreement") for the period of January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement include, but are not limited to, provisions regarding wages, hours, working conditions, employee benefits, and other terms of employment, all of which have been mutually agreed upon by the Township and the Union; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has reviewed the Agreement and finds that it is in the best interest of the Township and its employees to approve the Agreement as negotiated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, hereby acknowledges the receipt and review of the following informational update:

Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Township and AFSCME Council 73 AFL-CIO Local 3834 for the term commencing January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, a copy of this Resolution shall be filed in the office of the Township Clerk and made available to interested parties upon request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution, along with the executed Agreement, shall be forwarded to AFSCME Council 73 AFL-CIO Local 3834.
