Authorizing Acceptance of Grant – Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office Safer Travel Initiative

WHEREAS, over the past 5 years, more than 300 people have died on the roadways of Middlesex County, with 45 of them on U.S. Route 1; and

WHEREAS, the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office spearheaded the "Safer Travel Initiative" to reduce motor vehicle crash fatalities by 20% year over year by December 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick Police Department participated in this multijurisdictional Task Force created to enforce road safety tactics, targeting the behaviors that cause the greatest risk to the drivers, pedestrians, and pedal cyclists that use the roads in Middlesex County; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick desires to accept a reimbursement check for participating in the Safer Travel Initiative in the amount of \$11,900.00, with no matching funds required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor or his designee are authorized to execute and sign any and all documents in order to effectuate the receipt of reimbursement grant monies between the North Brunswick Township and the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey for participating in the Safer Travel Initiative in the amount of \$11,900.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office, the Township Business Administrator, the Township Chief Financial Officer, and Police Director, of the Township of North Brunswick.
