

PROCLAMATION

By Mayor and Council – Township of North Brunswick

WHEREAS, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, October 17, 2025 is National Mammography Day; and

WHEREAS, Breast Cancer is the most common cancer among women, except for Nonmelanoma Skin Cancers; and

WHEREAS, Breast Cancer is the second leading cause of Cancer death in women; and

WHEREAS, the chance of developing invasive Breast Cancer at some time in a woman's life is about 1 in 7; and

WHEREAS, death rates from Breast Cancer have been declining, and this change is believed to be the result of earlier detection and improved treatment; and

WHEREAS, mammography, an x-ray of the breast, is recognized as the single most effective method of detecting breast changes that may be cancer long before physical symptoms can be seen or felt; and

WHEREAS, North Brunswick's Care to Walk Club was formed in 2000. The Care to Walk Club is a group of dedicated North Brunswick Township High School students fighting the cause in support of others enduring the disease of cancer.

NOW THEREFORE, WE the Mayor and Council of the Township of North Brunswick, **Do Hereby Proclaim**, October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month and join the entire community in supporting early detection and working towards a cure.
