

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING MICHAEL MORIARTY AS
DEPUTY MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the New Jersey Civil Defense and Disaster Control Act, N.J.S.A. App.A:9-33 et seq., every municipality is required to establish and maintain a local Office of Emergency Management (OEM); and

WHEREAS, under the direction of the Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, a Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator assists in the planning, coordination, and execution of all emergency management functions, including preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation activities; and

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick finds it in the best interest of the municipality to formally appoint a second Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator to support the responsibilities of the OEM office; and

WHEREAS, Michael Moriarty, former North Brunswick Police Director and retired Regional Administrator – FPC at FEMA, has demonstrated both a distinguished record of service and a willingness to serve in this capacity for North Brunswick; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that Michael Moriarty is hereby appointed as a Deputy Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township of North Brunswick, effective immediately; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the New Jersey State Police Office of Emergency Management, the Middlesex County OEM Coordinator, and the Township Clerk for recordkeeping purposes.
