## Dear Mr. Semple:

I have reviewed the application for a variance at the above-referenced address, and I am issuing the following report.

The following application materials were reviewed:

o 1-sheet copy of the property survey prepared by Gregory Prochoren, P.L.S. Inc., dated 5/27/1992.

#### **Administrative**

- 1. The applicant proposes to install a 6 ft. privacy fence and an above ground swimming pool in the required 40 ft. front yard setback along South Barkley Place.
- 2. The subject property is a corner lot located at the intersection of South Barkley Place and Garner Road. The property has two front yards.
- 3. The subject property is a single-family dwelling located in the R-2 Residential Zoning District. Single-family use is a permitted use in the zone (Figures 1 & 2).

- 4. Variances associated with the development application are summarized in the following table(s):

#### **Technical**

#### Variances:

- 1. Fence in Front Yard, Height The applicant proposes to install a 6 ft. privacy fence in the required 40 ft. front yard setback along South Barkley Place, whereas only fences not exceeding 4 ft. in height above ground level may be permitted in the required front yard (§ 205-93 (A)(1)(a)). The applicant should justify this variance and provide testimony to satisfy the C-1 ("hardship") and/or C-2 ("benefits v. burdens") variance criteria.
- 2. Fence in Front Yard, Type The applicant proposes to install a 6 ft. privacy fence in the required 40 ft. front yard setback along South Barkley Place, whereas only open-type fences that are constructed in such a way that no more than 50% of the surface area of the fence obstructs a view through the fence from a position perpendicular to the fence may be permitted in the required front yard (§ 205-93 (A)(1)(a)). The applicant should justify this variance and provide testimony to satisfy the C-1 ("hardship") and/or C-2 ("benefits v. burdens") variance criteria.
- 3. Swimming Pool in Front Yard, The applicant proposes to install an above ground swimming pool in the required 40 ft. front yard setback along South Barkley Place, whereas detached accessory buildings, swimming pools and play courts shall be permitted in the rear yard only (§ 205-26.1 (B)). The applicant should justify this variance and provide testimony to satisfy the C-1 ("hardship") and/or C-2 ("benefits v. burdens") variance criteria.

The Township reserves the right to further comment based upon the testimony at the public hearing.

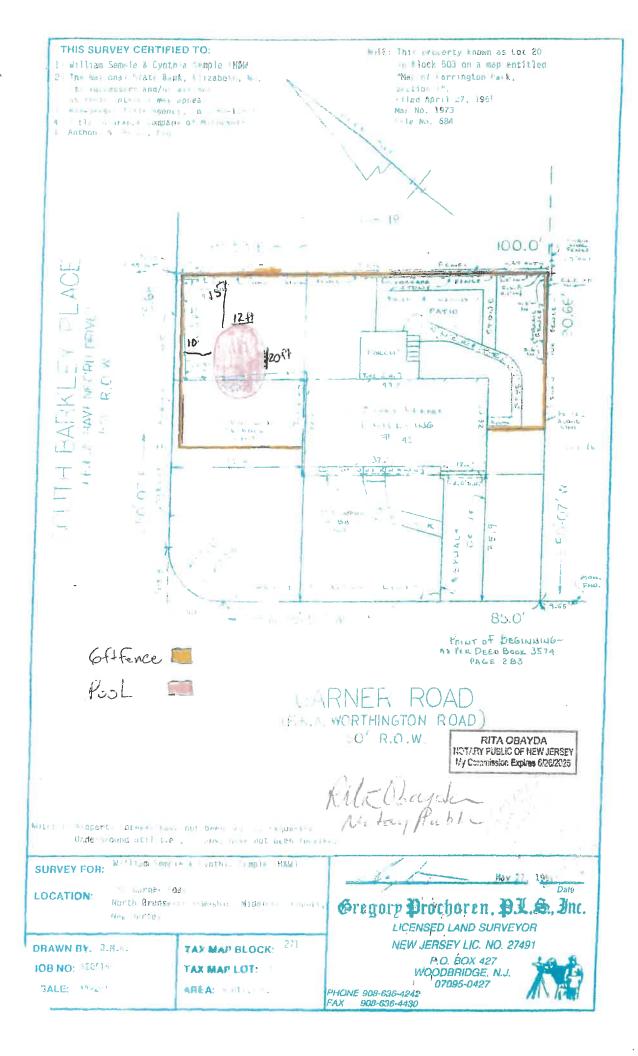

### Variance Application (FORM C)

The original and fourteen (14) copies of the completed application form supplied by the Township and the required number of copies of supporting documents listed in the applicable checklist must be filed with the Department of Community Development. If a waiver is being requested for any item on the checklist, it must be noted in the "waiver requested" section, and each item must be listed by checklist number and a detailed reason for the request must be provided. Any application that does not include an item required by the checklist, and for which a waiver has not been requested, will be automatically deemed incomplete.

All applications must be accompanied by appropriate fees and escrow deposits together with a written explanation of the amount calculations. Separate application fee and escrow deposit checks must be provided.

In addition to submittal of hard copies of documents, copies of all applications, surveys, plans, reports and studies, such as environmental impact, traffic, stormwater, sewer and water reports, and any other documents associated with the application, shall be submitted on a CD in portable document format (pdf) at 400 × 400 dpi. Submittal of such digital copies shall be required to constitute an application for development, and all revised files shall be resubmitted as the originals are changed or amended. Every electronic submission must be accompanied by a cover letter listing all attached documents and any revisions, where applicable. Single-family or two-family homeowners preparing variance applications on their own behalf shall not be subject to this electronic submission requirement, provided that such applications do not require site plan or subdivision approval.

The following proof of satisfying the notice requirements must be filed with the Secretary of the appropriate Board at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the hearing:

- Affidavit of Service
- Copy of notice served
- Certified List of Property Owners within 200 feet and others served with manner of service
- Certified Mail receipts stamped by the USPS
- Affidavit of Publication from the newspaper in which the notice was published.

#### **ESCROW FUNDS AGREEMENT:**

The Municipal Land Use Law (N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et seq.) authorizes the collection of Technical Review Escrow Fees to cover the costs incurred by the Township for professional services involved in the review of land use development applications. Subsection 205-139 of the North Brunswick Township Land Use Ordinance establishes the amount of Technical Review Escrow Fees and the procedures for collecting and replenishing same. I hereby acknowledge and agree to the following: 1) I am responsible for the cost of all reasonable professional services rendered to the Planning Board or Board of Adjustment during the review and processing of my development application. 2) If I receive a written Deficiency Notice from the Chief Financial Officer or his/her designee (CFO) that the balance of funds remaining in the account is insufficient to cover invoices, vouchers or bills submitted to the Township for services which have already been performed, no further consideration, review or processing of the application will be permitted until such time as the funds requested in the Deficiency Notice have been deposited, and this cessation of work could result in carrying my application to the next regularly scheduled public meeting of the designated land use agency. 3) Failure to deposit the amount requested in the Deficiency Notice within ten days of receipt shall toll the period for action by the Planning Board or Board of Adjustment as stipulated in N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et seq., and shall bar me from seeking a default approval under N.J.S.A. 40:55D-10.4. 4) Failure to post funds requested in the Deficiency Notice within 45 days shall be grounds for dismissal of my application without prejudice, and I acknowledge that failure to pay the shortfall shall result in the shortfall being deemed a lien on the property which is subject of the land development application. 5) In the event that my application is approved and a Deficiency Notice is received after the approval is memorialized, failure to pay the shortfall amount shall be grounds for voiding the approval. 6) In the event that my application is denied and a Deficiency Notice is received after the denial is memorialized, I am still obligated to pay any shortfall amount, and I acknowledge that failure to pay the shortfall shall result in the shortfall being deemed a lien on the property which is subject of the land development application.
