**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF NORTH BRUNSWICK  
AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION OF A FEDERAL GRANT FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of North Brunswick desires to apply for and accept the HTS FED-2027-NBT-00146 Grant for the North Brunswick Township Police Department Traffic Safety Bureau's THINK.ACT.LIVE Community Traffic Safety Initiative as part of the Statewide Enforcement Mobilization reimbursement funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 to reduce motor vehicle crashes, injuries, and fatalities on the roads of New Jersey through high visibility enforcement in targeted areas and noted crash hotspots; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey will participate in the HTS FED-2027-NBT-00146 Grant from October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027 in an effort to: promote voluntary compliance with all traffic laws, improve driving behavior for all drivers, reduce traffic related hotspot incidents by 5%; and reduce distracted driving related incidents by 5%.

**WHEREAS**, it would be in the best interest of North Brunswick Township to accept said monies, with no matching funds required. The maximum project overtime rate is \$70.00 per hour. Officers paid more than \$70.00 per hour will be reimbursed at \$70.00 per hour by the grant with the municipality covering the remainder of the rate;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor or his designee are authorized to execute and sign any and all documents in order to effectuate the receipt of federal grant monies between the North Brunswick Township and the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety for the HTS FED-2027-NBT-00146 Grant in the amount of \$25,000.00.
