**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION OF A FEDERAL GRANT FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick desires to apply for the HTS PED-2027-NBT-00039 Grant for the North Brunswick Township Police Department Traffic Safety Bureau's participation in the Pedestrian Safety Enforcement & Education Program Fund 2027 consisting of overtime hours to be worked during FY2027 in the amount of \$21,000.00 to provide high visibility overtime enforcement with a goal of reducing motor vehicle crashes, injuries, and fatalities on North Brunswick Township and the state of New Jersey roadways specifically in high targeted areas and noted crash hotspots; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the HTS PED-2027-NBT-00039 Grant from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 with focused efforts to: educate the public including children, adults, senior citizens and non-English speaking residents; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of North Brunswick Township to accept said monies, with no matching funds required. The maximum project overtime rate is \$70.00 per hour. Officers paid more than \$70.00 per hour will be reimbursed at \$70.00 per hour by the grant with the municipality covering the remainder of the rate;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor or his designee are authorized to execute and sign any and all documents in order to effectuate the receipt of federal grant monies between North Brunswick Township and the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety for the HTS PED-2027-NBT-00039 Grant in the amount of \$21,000.00.
