**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACT TO CIVICPLUS, LLC FOR
MUNICIPAL WEBSITE SERVICES – NTE \$52,951.10**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick has identified the need to upgrade and enhance its municipal website to improve public communication, accessibility, and digital service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that these services shall be awarded as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., the New Jersey Pay-to-Play Law; and

WHEREAS, CivicPlus, LLC, 302 S. 4th Street, Suite 500, Manhattan, Kansas 66502, has submitted a proposal to provide municipal website services to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the term of this contract shall be for municipal website services in an amount not to exceed \$52,951.10; and

WHEREAS, CivicPlus, LLC has completed and submitted the required Business Entity Disclosure Certification, certifying that the entity has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of North Brunswick that would bar the award of this contract and that the contract will prohibit CivicPlus, LLC from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and Political Contribution Disclosure Form shall be placed on file with this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with CivicPlus, LLC for municipal website services.
2. The contract shall be awarded as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.
3. The contract amount shall not exceed \$52,951.10;
4. A copy of this resolution and the contract shall be kept on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk and available for public inspection.
5. Notice of this action shall be published as required by law.
6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
