**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH BRUNSWICK
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR FUNDING
TO SUPPORT THE RENOVATION AND REPURPOSING OF A MUNICIPAL BUILDING
INTO A COMMUNITY AND RECREATION CENTER**

WHEREAS, the Township of North Brunswick desires to enhance recreational, social, and community programming opportunities for residents of all ages, including youth, seniors, and families; and

WHEREAS, the Township owns and maintains a municipal building located at 15 Linwood Place, adjacent to Linwood School and in close proximity to Babbage Park; and

WHEREAS, the building currently houses the Township Food Bank and Senior Citizen Center, which provides a wide range of programs and services for residents aged 55 and older; and

WHEREAS, the Township is in the process of relocating the Food Bank operations to newly renovated space at the Municipal Complex within the Community Resilience Center; and

WHEREAS, the relocation of the Food Bank creates an opportunity to repurpose the existing space at 15 Linwood Place into a flexible, dual-purpose Senior Center and Community Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will improve indoor environmental conditions, including ventilation enhancements, and expand programming opportunities for seniors during daytime hours and youth during after-school and evening hours; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to maximize the use of existing municipal assets by renovating and repurposing the building rather than constructing a new facility, thereby promoting cost-effective use of taxpayer resources; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to submit a grant application in the amount of \$1,650,000 to support the renovation and repurposing of the building into a Community and Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council believe that this project will provide long-term benefits to the community by enhancing recreational opportunities, supporting youth engagement, and improving services for senior residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 23 day of March, 2026, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of North Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Township hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$1,650,000 for the purpose of renovating and repurposing the municipal building located at 15 Linwood Place into a Community and Recreation Center.
2. The Mayor and/or Business Administrator are hereby authorized to execute and submit all documents necessary to apply for and secure such funding, and to take any additional actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
3. Upon award, the Township shall accept the funding and proceed in accordance with all applicable grant requirements.
